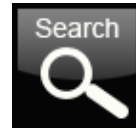

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Clinton Community School District, Rock and Walworth Counties, Wisconsin that there shall be issued pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$9,630,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of making security and safety improvements to all District buildings; replacing the HVAC (heating, ventilating, and air cooling) system and making site improvements at the Elementary School; upgrading and improving the plumbing, electrical and fire protection systems and undertaking various repair, replacement and improvement projects at the Elementary and Middle Schools; constructing kitchen, music, art, office and gym additions at the Elementary School (gym and office additions allowing for traffic and safety improvements); and acquiring furniture, fixtures and equipment at all District buildings.
