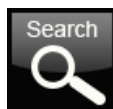

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,500,000 BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Salem School District, Kenosha County, Wisconsin that there shall be issued pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of undertaking various maintenance, replacement, repair and improvement projects at the Salem Elementary School building and site including projects to improve energy efficiency, ADA compliance, roofing, paving, security, fire safety and general maintenance and repairs and constructing and equipping an addition to the building."

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET TO EXCEED REVENUE LIMIT FOR RECURRING PURPOSES BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Salem School District, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, that the revenues included in the School District budget be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, for the 2008-2009 school year by \$640,000; for the 2009-2010 school year by an additional \$470,000 (for a total of \$1,110,000); for the 2010-2011 school year by an additional \$210,000 (for a total of \$1,320,000) and for the 2011-2012 and thereafter by an additional \$275,000 (for a total of \$1,595,000 per year), for recurring purposes.
